 Organist Position

This is a half-time position.* It is expected an average work week will total 20 hours. Actual working hours vary depending on season and time of year. Beyond time necessary for musical preparation and administration, the following time requirements are ongoing, except during the summer choir hiatus and vacations. *Currently much of this schedule has been necessarily suspended and is being altered due to impact of the coronavirus pandemic. The schedule below necessarily looks to the fuller schedule offerings of the position planned to return.*

For the duties as listed among responsibilities, the annual salary, benefits and vacation time are as follows:

Annual Salary:	\$31,000
Continuing Education:	\$1,000 per year plus Presbyterian Association of Musicians membership
Weddings (each)	\$300
Funerals (each)	\$200
Paid vacation	Three weeks/Sundays (predominantly in summer)
Additional leave	Two weeks/Sundays (recitals, teaching, continuing ed.)
Benefits	Health Benefits available (Medical, Prescription)

* - Position of Handbell Director (c. 6 hours per week) comes open in January and may be added to expand the position and salary for an interested/qualified candidate. Those handbell rehearsals are currently Tuesday (7:30-8:30) and Wednesday (4:10-4:55 and 6:15-7:15).
